## **2009-2010 HBPW Officers Elected**

HOLLAND, MI., August 26, 2009 -- Holland Board of Public Works board officers were elected at their August 10<sup>th</sup> meeting. The Board unanimously voted Jim Storey to serve as chairperson, and Tim Hemingway as the new vice chairperson. The terms of office are for one year.

Storey, who brings experience in utility operations, has been serving as vice chairperson since January 2009. Hemingway retired last fall as president of SAF-Holland following a 34-year career. Both are residents of Holland.

Other HBPW board members include: Richard Cook, Paul Elzinga, and Diane Haworth. City Manager Soren Wolff serves on the board as an Ex Officio member.

The Holland Board of Public Works is responsible for overseeing the municipally owned and operated enterprise that provides electricity, fiber optics, water filtration and wastewater treatment services to 28,000 customers in the City of Holland and the surrounding communities.
