HBPW receives notice concerning proposed Air Quality Permit and Public Hearing

HOLLAND, MI -- The Holland Board of Public Works has received notice from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) that it will solicit comments regarding the proposed air quality construction permit.

The Holland BPW submitted a request to the MDEQ in January 2007 for an air quality permit. The sixty day public comment period begins November 26, 2008 until January 30, 2009.
