Holland Board of Public Works Releases 2010 Water Quality Report

HOLLAND, MI., June 23, 2011 – The Holland Board of Public Works has distributed its 2010 Water Quality Report to water customers and made it available via the Internet at www.hollandbpw.com. The report indicates that the Holland Water Treatment System met all federal and state drinking water regulations without exception during the period from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.

In accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), all community water utilities are required to annually provide this report. The report is distributed each year and encompasses important information about Holland water for the previous year.

As a state certified microbiological laboratory, the HBPW's Water Treatment Plant in conjunction with three independent laboratories, conducted over 50,000 tests encompassing more than 200 contaminants during 2010.

The Holland BPW has been providing water to the area for over 115 years, and is presently responsible for providing drinking water in the City of Holland, City of Zeeland and portions of Holland, Laketown, Park and Zeeland Townships. **The HBPW has consistently safeguarded its water supply and maintained a system which has never violated a maximum contaminant level or any other water quality standard.**
