(Bill Codes: EBI, EBI1)**

Effective Date:

Rate increase effective for bills issued June 1, 2011 and thereafter.

Availability:

Available for use to all industrial customers

Character of Service:

Alternating current, 60 hertz single or three phase. The nature of the voltage is to be determined by the Board of Public Works.

Rates:

Readiness to Serve Charge.....	\$94.09 per month
Renewable Energy Charge.....	\$0.02 per kWh
Minimum Charge.....	\$5.00 per month plus
Maximum Charge.....	\$187.50 per month
Delivery Charge.....	\$0.0360 per kWh
Energy Charge.	\$0.0621 per kWh per month (November – April)
Energy Charge.	\$0.0746 per kWh per month (May – October)

Minimum Charge is the sum of the charges listed below on all active accounts per meter.**

- Readiness to Serve Charge
- Renewable Energy Minimum Charge
- Optimization Charge (*Please refer to the Energy Optimization Charge Schedule*)

**Active accounts are services with installed meters that are available for customer use.

Terms and Conditions of Service:

The obligations of both parties commence when the Board of Public Works begins to supply service and continues until either party has received from the other written notice to discontinue service; and thereafter for a reasonable time for making disconnections, not-to-exceed ten (10) days.

Service will not be furnished hereunder for other power apparatus in which the use of electricity is subject to violent fluctuation; the operation of which may interfere with lighting service.

The rate is subject to revision at any time during the Term of Service upon approval by the Board of Public Works and City Council.

The interruption of electric current delivery in whole or in part under this schedule shall not be the basis for claims for damage or loss.

Service will be further governed by the Board of Public Works standard rules and regulations.
