



**Holland Board of Public Works
Rate CI
(Bill Codes: ECI, ECI1)**

Effective Date:

Rate increase effective for bills issued June 1, 2011 and thereafter.

Availability:

Available to any industrial customer using permanently installed electric heating equipment as the primary source of space heating. Service will be supplied through a separate meter to which no other device except electric air-conditioning equipment or electric water heater(s) may be connected.

Character of Service:

Alternating current, 60 hertz, single phase, 120/240 nominal volts. Three phase service as required, subject to availability.

Rates:

Readiness to Serve Charge.....\$94.09 per month plus
Renewable Energy Charge.....\$187.50 per month plus

Delivery Charge.....\$0.0360 per kWh

Energy Charge...\$0.0413 per kWh per month (November – April)

Energy Charge...\$0.0746 per kWh per month (May-October)

Minimum Charge is the sum of the charges listed below on all active accounts per meter.**

- Readiness to Serve Charge
- Renewable Energy Minimum Charge
- Optimization Charge (*Please refer to the Energy Optimization Charge Schedule*)

**Active accounts are services with installed meters that are available for customer use.

Terms and Conditions of Service:

The obligation of both parties commences when the Board of Public Works begins to supply service and continues one year thereafter until either party has received from the other written notice to discontinue service; thereafter for a reasonable time to make disconnections not-to-exceed ten (10) days. The Board of Public Works may require a longer term contract in cases involving unusual expense to provide service.

The rate is subject to revision at any time during the Term of Service upon approval by the Board of Public Works and City Council.

The interruption of electric current delivery in whole or in part under this schedule shall not be the basis for claims for damage or loss.

Service will be further governed by the Board of Public Works standard rules and regulations.
