



**Holland Board of Public Works  
General Primary Service  
Rate FC**

**Effective Date:**

Rate increase effective July 1, 2009.

**Availability:**

Available for use to all Commercial customers

**Character of Service:**

Alternating current, 60 hertz, three phases. The nature of the voltage to be determined by the Board of Public Works.

**Rates:**

Readiness to Serve Charge.....\$16.10 per month plus  
Renewable Energy Charge.....\$16.58 per month plus  
Energy Optimization Charge.....\$5.41 per month plus

**Capacity Charge:**

\$7.21 per KW of on-peak billing period demand, plus  
\$1.96 per KW of maximum billing period demand.

**Energy Charge:**

\$0.0523 per kWh for all kWh consumed during the on-peak period.  
\$0.0503 per kWh for all kWh consumed during the off peak period.

**Minimum Charge:**

500 KW per month of on-peak billing demand plus Readiness to Serve Charge plus Renewable Energy Charge plus Energy Optimization Charge on all active accounts\*\*per meter.

\*\*Active accounts are services with installed meters that are available for customer use.

**On-Peak hours:**

The following schedule shall apply Monday through Friday (except holidays designated by the Board of Public Works). Weekends and holidays are considered off-peak.

On-peak – 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.  
Off-peak – 6 p.m. to 10 a.m.

**Designated Holidays:**

- New Years Day – January 1
- Memorial Day – Last Monday in May
- Independence Day – July 4
- Labor Day – First Monday in September
- Thanksgiving Day – fourth Thursday of November
- Christmas Day – December 25

Whenever a holiday falls on a weekend, neither the Friday nor the Monday will be considered as holidays for application of off-peak hours.

**Transformer Ownership Discount:**

When the customer furnishes and maintains the complete transformer, including switches, and other apparatus; if such transformers are satisfactory to the Board of Public Works, a credit of \$0.45 per KW of maximum billing demand will be allowed on each monthly bill. In addition, any customer who is primary metered will receive a three (3) percent discount on all KWH used.

**Billing Demand:**

The on-peak billing demand for the month shall be the maximum fifteen (15) minute integrated rolling demand that occurs during the on-peak hours. This amount shall not be less than 60% of the highest on-peak demand during the preceding 12 months and not less than 500 KW. The maximum demand charge shall be the maximum fifteen (15) minute integrated rolling demand during the current month or the previous eleven months.

**Terms and Conditions of Service:**

The obligations of both parties commence when the Board of Public Works begins to supply service and continues until the Board of Public Works receives written notice of a request to discontinue service, change to another rate or the average power factor for the customer drops below 80%. If a customer elects to switch to another rate or is removed from Rate "F" for low power factor, they must wait 12 months before returning to this rate. If a customer requests to discontinue service, the Board of Public Works will have a reasonable time to make the disconnections not-to-exceed ten (10) days.

Applications for power service which involve unusual expenditures for line and transformer construction will be subject to special consideration as to term of contract and minimum revenue to be received.

Rate "F" must be used for the entire site.

No equipment for welding requiring more than 75 KW will be connected except by special permission of the Board of Public Works.

The rate is subject to revision at any time during the Term of Service upon approval by the Board of Public Works and City Council.

The interruption of electric current delivery in whole or in part under this schedule shall not be the basis for claims for damage or loss.

Service will be further governed by the Board of Public Works standard rules and regulations.
