



**Holland Board of Public Works  
Combined Lighting and Power General Service  
Rate MI  
(Bill Codes: EMI, EMBI, EMRI)**

**Effective Date:**

Rate increase effective for bills issued June 1, 2011 and thereafter.

**Availability:**

Available for use to all industrial customers.

**Character of Service:**

Alternating current, 60 hertz, three phases. The nature of the voltage is to be determined by the Board of Public Works.

**Rates:**

Readiness to Serve Charge.....\$94.09 per month  
Renewable Energy Charge.....\$187.50 per month  
  
Delivery Charge.....\$2.11 per KW  
  
Capacity Charge.....\$7.38 per kW for all of billing demand  
  
Energy Charge.....\$0.0523 per kWh

**Minimum Charge is the sum of the charges listed below on all active accounts\*\* per meter.**

- 25 KW per month of billing demand
- Readiness to Serve Charge
- Delivery Charge
- Renewable Energy Charge
- Energy Optimization Charges (*Please refer to the Energy Optimization Charge Schedule*)

\*\*Active accounts are services with installed meters that are available for customer use.

**Transformer Ownership Discount:**

When the customer furnishes and maintains the complete transformer, including switches, transformer(s) and other apparatus; if such transformer is satisfactory to the Board of Public Works, a credit of \$0.45 per KW of maximum billing demand will be allowed on each monthly bill. In addition, any customer who is primary metered will receive a three (3) percent discount on all kWh used.

**Billing Demand:**

The billing demand for the month shall be the maximum fifteen (15) minute integrated demand in the month, but not less than 60% of the highest demand established during the preceding twelve (12) months and not less than 25 KW.

**Controlled Large General Service Load:**

For loads of 1,000 KW or more that are controlled to permit use only during hours as established by the Board of Public Works, the capacity charges may be reduced by 50%

with prior Board of Public Works approval. The controlled load shall be separately served and metered and shall at no time be connected to facilities serving the customers' controlled load. Service under this schedule may be disconnected at the discretion of the Board of Public Works anytime during on-peak hours or during periods of system emergencies.

**Terms and Conditions of Service:**

The obligations of both parties commence when the Board of Public works begins to supply service and continue for one year and, thereafter until either party shall have received from the other written notice to discontinue service, and thereafter for a reasonable time to make disconnection's not-to-exceed ten (10) days, provided that the Board of Public Works may require a longer term contract in cases involving unusual expense to make the service available.

Applications for power service which involve unusual expenditures for line and transformer construction will be subject to special consideration as to term of contract and minimum revenue to be received.

No equipment for welding requiring more than 75 KW will be connected except by special permission of the Board of Public Works.

The rate is subject to revision at any time during the Term of Service upon approval by the Board of Public Works and City Council.

The interruption of electric current delivery in whole or in part under this schedule shall not be the basis for claims for damage or loss.

Service will be further governed by the Board of Public Works standard rules and regulations.
